### **A&WMA 2022 Scholarship Awards**

The Louisiana Section Air and Waste Management Association (A&WMA) completed its 2022 Scholarship program for the Fall 2022 / Spring 2023 school year. Two scholarships were awarded in 2022 to two recipients - one from Louisiana State University (LSU) and one from Southern University in Baton Rouge.
