



You can click on the various report numbers to identify the various chapters. A pdf document is included on numbers. Sections & Chapters Number Listing.

You have two ways to export data, (1) After clicking the link of the report you want, enter in just one chapter number (for example 183). Just keying in one number will provide you with the information just for chapter number 183 which happens to be "Southern Section: Alabama Chapter". (2) If you wish to pull an entire section, then you need to know each chapter number that comprises the section. See the sample graphic below that would be used to pull data for the entire Allegheny Mountain Section. The numbers have to be in quotes, and separated by comma's

## Conference & Events

Major events planned for 2012 include some returning favorites – and continuing our successful 2011 Workshops:

- Symposium on Air Quality Measurement Methods and Technology
   2010 brought a record attendance of 219 individuals.
- IT3/HWC International Conference on Thermal Treatment Technologies and Hazardous Waste Combustors— this conference is growing and in 2012 will be held in the Fall rather than the Spring.
- Vapor Intrusion Started in 2006 and held every 14 18 months.
   2010 brought in over 150 attendees.
- Visibility Conference Last held in 2008. Over 110 people attended this conference.
- Power Plant Air Pollutant Control "MEGA" Symposium In 2010 profited over \$ 250K.
- Permitting Workshops were a huge success in 2011 and reintroduced Revenue Sharing with the Sections – 5 held in 2011, 3 planned for 2012.



- ✓ Social Events raised \$3,400 for the Scholarship fund


