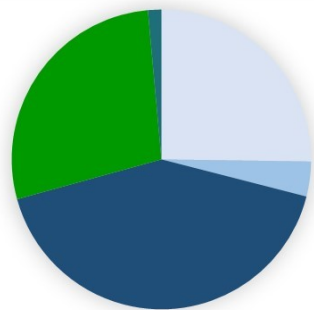

Attendees spend organized time outside of each session in the exhibition space— every breakfast, break, and every lunch. 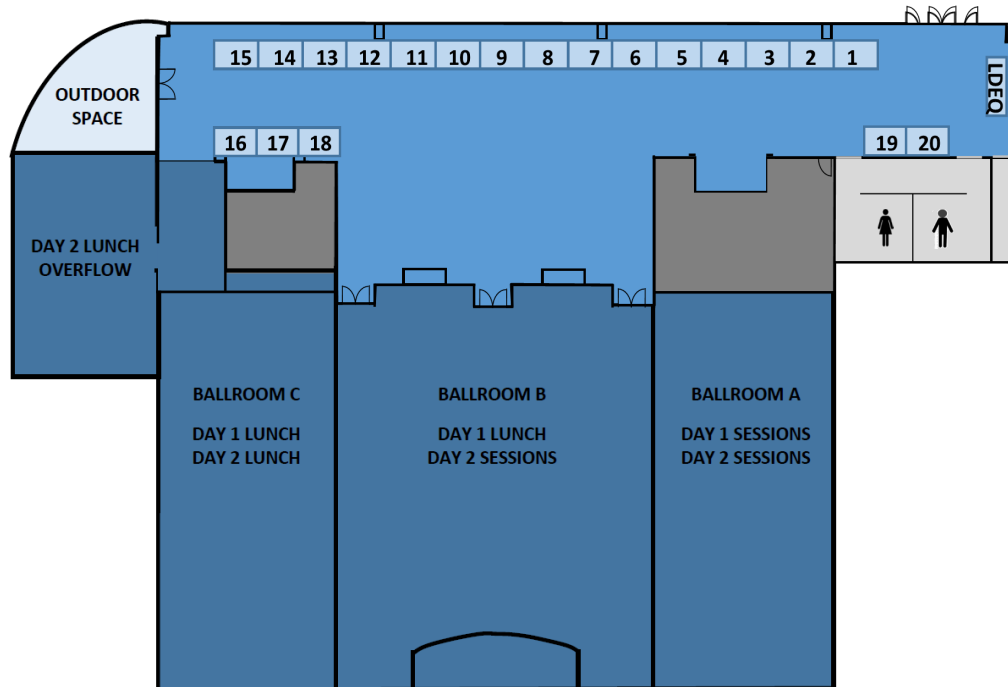


EXHIBIT INFORMATION

The exhibit space is behind a secured area immediately adjacent to the meeting rooms. The booths are 10 feet wide by 8 feet deep and include the following equipment:

- Piping and draping
- Standard electrical connection
- One (1) skirted table and two (2) chairs
- Waste basket
